Dear Sir:

In reference to the S. A. E. National Convention at Pittsburgh the following accommodations have been made for your convenience.

Please observe them carefully and notify me not later than Sat. Noon Dec. 28th if you are unable to accept the various reservations or make your arrangements comply with those stated.

Tickets have been reserved for you on the train leaving South Station, Boston at 5.34 P.M. Dec. 28th

Pullman chairs have been reserved on this train @ \$1.00

Tickets have been reserved for you on the train leaving Penna. R. R. Station, New York at 1.30 A.M. the morning of Dec. 28th @ \$9.50

Berths have been reserved for you on this train @ \$2.00

upper — for a ~~upper~~ berth. If you prefer another berth you will have to swap with one of the party in N. Y. as we had to take some uppers. Berths ready on your arrival in N.Y.

On account of the great excess travel on those dates it is absolutely necessary in order to secure these reservations, that you forward me the amount of \$12.75 for your tickets and Pullman accommodations as indicated above so that remittance will reach me not later than Noon of Sat. Dec. 28th.

Your ticket from Boston to New York will be paid for by me and deposited at the Pullman ticket window, South Station, Boston in your name.

Your ticket from New York to Pittsburgh will be obtained in New York by Bro. Peters. This will be a party ticket and Bro. Peters will tender the ticket for your fare so that you will not have to bother about a ticket after leaving Boston.

These conditions all depend on all of the party sending the money to me promptly. In case some of the party fail to comply the conditions will be the same for those who do send their money, except that the tickets from N. Y. to Pittsburgh will be reserved in the name of E. M. Peters up to midnight Dec. 28th at the ticket window Penna. R. R. Station, New York and you will have to call at the ticket window and get your ticket individually by asking for one of the tickets reserved for Mr. Peters and paying \$11.50 plus berth charges, for each ticket wanted.

There has also been reserved for you at the Wm. Penn Hotel a *single* room at \$2.50 per day. You are to share this room with Bro. ~~and there will be separate beds therein.~~

The above arrangements are the best that can be made under the circumstances and I trust they will prove satisfactory.
