also fighting time these days.

Great day today - sunny
and warm - and the airplanes
are having a great old time.
I really believe the mud is
drying up a bit, because it
sticks more than ever. Another
thing too, It's light enough
in the morning to see to
get up.

Sat my first mail today -

my mileage voucher from Paris to here, and my glasses from England. was glad to see them, you bet, because I despaired of ever seeing them again. Now that the channel is open maybe I'll get word from you. Yesterday Couley got a letter mailed in Wyo. on Dec. 22. I'll eat those letters when they come. maybe by now you feel the same.

Pines went to Paris Friday on his way to some job, and I had him cable \$30. to you. It isn't much, but if those allotments haven't come, it will pay carfare for a time. I've wondered how you made it

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so far. Leave it to you to manage - only you'll deny yourself things that you should have.

Had a Corps reunion of Signal Officers in a town a few miles from here last night. We were all there from the Colonel down, some coming up from the front, and a great old party it was. There were eats - some champagne and smokes - speeches, toasts and all that goes with a good stag affair. They're a great bunch - this

Signal Corps. Even if you don't
now - someday you will be
glad that your Dummie was
of the 1st Corps - the bunch
that led the way. These fel-
lows are nearly all regular
army men - the best in the
business, and we are con-
sidered well enough to help
them put it over.

My cold is all better
now, except that I can't
sing yet. That will come soon.

instructors will play the British
