moved out today. Brownie

decided I'd better be out
with my company 'cause I
know they need me. Sonra
have the best one in the
A.E.F. The only reason I wanted
to stay in Montabaur was
to be away from that major
who refused to be evacuated.
He's gone to school now, and
probably won't come back.

The other day Col. Hanley
bought an English saddle
in Coblenz - a wonderful
affair - and a beautiful
bridle too. He turned it
over to me and maybe I
won't make some splurge
with it. The weather has
turned to Spring the last
two days - and I'm aching
to be in the saddle all

say. Isn't it wonderful
tho! and I've a dog - only
a puppy a month old now -
but he'll be some dog
before ^{long}! His Ma and
Pa are German police dogs -
and they are wonders. Smart-
pretty & all dog. The
pups belong to Cal. Har-
sley and one of the fine
babies went to me. I'm
going to work all ~~the~~ morning
and play with my horse and
dog all afternoon till they
let me come home. See
wish they'd do that pretty
soon.

The official copies of the
history have gone - did I tell
you that? I'll be sending
one to you in a day or so.
G'wan like that? Please don't
criticize too harshly - nor
throw any heavy ~~logs~~ logs.

next thing is to get it printed.

Have a pretty nice place here in Halbach - almost as nice as Montabaur in some respects - and better in others. Silent. white and I have two rooms - one to live in and the other to sleep in. and today Doc Campbell is in Cabling seeing about renting a piano for the living room. Oh we take pretty good care of ourselves - but we all want to go home.

Got a life yesterday - but no letters for several days. mail from the States comes very irregularly. But I'm not worrying now 'cause you said the roses had ~~sent~~ come back and you made me happy. That's a sure sign I'll see you soon. Don't you get scared - they'd never be shipping good divisions like the 42nd and the 89th home, if there's more work to do. and hasn't Wilson said that no more Americans go to Russia - and that those who are there come out right away? You bet it's me for home tout-de-suite.

So long - Kiddie mine - sure I loves you - a lot - a heap - a Pyle - and love saved a big bunch of hugs and kisses - saved all of 'em - every single one just for you, my sweet wife. and I'm wanting to deliver them - How care?! x x x 'Aw wigget I'm coming -
