Coblenz May 28, 1919.

Kiddie mine,

Just a wee note to enclose
a few pictures that I know you've
wanted - and to tell you how well
I am. I was to have left today, but
there was a tangle somewhere, and
I'll go Saturday or Sunday. So you see
you'll have to keep all the news
and gossip till I come 'cause none
can reach me here now.

Having a good time batting
around Coblenz. Went out to the
Battalion yesterday and said my
last good bye. I hate to have to
leave I rank to the mercy of these
Boche girls - you know how he
is.

yep this is Cantigny's birthday.
I've been living those few days.

over again in my mind, and it didn't seem possible that such things ever happened.

And Eva should be with you now - Isn't that wonderful. Won't she have a great time with all the Uncles and cousins and Aunts. And won't they have a great time - too.

You'll be hearing from me, Sweetheart, as I go along even if some of the letters ~~of~~ don't get to you till after I get home.

I should certainly be there by July 1st, and by that time I'll be all ready for discharge, or at least a two months sick leave on full pay. That won't be hard to take, will it? Loving you - a lot - most like I couldn't hold all the love till they let me see you.
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
