Mrs J. J. McCluer. "Ne." Nancy to Luthill (Grandmother)
 Born in Willsbury Falls. Essex Co. N.Y. Feb 28th 1818
 Moved with team from home in New York to Jackson Co Ill
 in 1836. On way met J. J. McCluer (Grandfather) who was moving
 with his Parents from Babbille Richland County Ohio with team
 to Murphysborough. Jackson Co Ill. They were married.
 March 26th 1840. Moved with team to Duquoin. Perry Co Ill
 in 1841. Moved via team to Allendale Worth Co Missouri
 in 1864. In 1891 gave up their home in Missouri to visit
 spent July August and a part of September with M. Pyle and
 family in White Sulphur Springs Montana. Thence to
 California to spend the winter. returned to White Sulphur
 Springs the following spring and spent the summer at
 the home of M. Pyle. Thence to Garden Plains Kansas.
 to home of Wm McCluer (older son.) Thence to Allendale Mo
 to the home of Uncle Dringt Campbell where Grandfather died
 March 20th 1903. Grand Mother made her home after Grand
 Father's death part of the time with Uncle William
 McCluer. And part of the time with Uncle Daniel
 McCluer and died at the home of Daniel McCluer on
 Feb 25th 1913. She would have been 95 years old had
 she lived three days longer.

Grand Mother's parents Daniel Arnold. and his wife
 Parents were the earliest settlers of Manhattan Island
 New York landing there in 1810 from Holland.
 If you can get the history of the early settlers of Manhattan
 Island you will find their names mentioned and can
 find out what ships brought them. Daniel Arnold was
 quite a man in his day.

Nancy Wheeler Inthill was born
in Essex Co. - Willsbury Falls. New York. Feb. 28 - 1818.
Moved with her parents to Jackson Co. Ills. in 1836.
Married to James J. McCluer March 26th 1840.
They moved to DuQuoin, Perry Co. Ills. in 1841.
From DuQuoin to Allenville Worth Co. Missouri in 1864.
In 1891, gave up their home to visit. Spent July,
Aug. & part of Sept. in Mont. Then went to California
to spend the winter with their youngest daughter.
Mrs Nancy Inthill Snodgrass, in the Spring came
back to Mont. for a few months. then went to Kansas
for a few years. then back to Missouri & lived
with their second daughter till he died - at the age
of 85 years & 8 months. She lived for ten years longer
part of the time with the oldest son William, in Kansas
& part at Samuel J. McCluer (the second son). She died
there at its age of 94 - 11 & 25 days. Had she lived till
she would have been 95 years old.

That's about all I know about my mother & Father,

Mother died on Feb 25th 1893 (I think)
3 days before her 95th Birthday

Well Ruth its time I was getting supper
but I was going to send you letter to Billie so I
must cut part of it first - as I'm so forgetful. so here goes
The first Ruth ^{Agnes} I know of was Fathers sister. I suppose you
know that fathers Great Grand father (his Grandfather) was born
in mid ~~atlantic~~ ^{atlantic} & they were Irish & settled in Virginia,
& when my Grandfather was a young man they had moved to
Ohio & he married an Irish girl - her name was Susan - but
I cant remember the last name - they he was a Catholic & you
know they must name the children - at least one bible name. their
oldest girl named Mary - she died when a child the next ^{year} to
was a girl & her name was Ruth Ann & when I was little
uncle George - fathers brother - wanted me called Ruth Ann too
thats how I got my name - & I have 2 or 3 cousins Ruth - & know
there several called Ruth in the Pyle family as well as the
McCluers. thats all I know of Ruth Ann - & know ^{supper} but
well now its Sunday morning July 5 - so
I'll write a little more & send you a little letter.
we had several grape shocks a week ago today
one of them so hard I shot the South East corner
of the house was tumbling down, but was only
the plaster falling (its daubing) the sand just ground
between the logs - & loosened lots of it & some of it fell.
& more will fall before cold weather.
